
Welcome to Charlotte, also known as the Queen City, in honor of Charlotte of Mecklenburg-Strelitz, the queen consort of British King George III during the time of the city's founding. We're a rapidly growing city and are now the 16th most populous city in the U.S. with about 113 people moving into our region daily.

Home to more than 10 Fortune 1000 companies, including household names such as Bank of America, Lowe's and Duke Energy, Charlotte continues to rank as one of the top cities for businesses, careers, job openings, and employee engagement.

The city is well-rounded with nearly 40 colleges and universities within a 25 mile radius, making it a great spot for aspiring professionals. In fact, there's been a 32% increase in job growth for young adults between the ages of 20-34.

Just a few hours from either the beaches or the mountains, there's so much to explore and experience to keep you busy and feeling like you're able to create more long weekend vacations within driving distance.

UPTOWN CHARLOTTE

Uptown is where you'll find the luxury classic *Ritz-Carlton* or experience the glamour of *Grand Bohemian*, both on Trade St. If historical



elegance is more your style then stay at *The Ivey's Hotel*. Need to stay close to the convention center? *The Westin, JW Marriott* and *Homes2 Suites by Hilton* will be right there, and within half a mile you'll find *Omni, Hyatt Place*, and the *Hampton Inn* all in close proximity to the center and plenty of dining options.

CLOSE TO THE AIRPORT

Making it a quick trip and want to stay close to the airport? Here are the top rated locations: Hampton Inn & Suites CLT Airport, Springhill Suites by Marriott, Residence Inn by Marriott, Fairfield Inn & Suites by Marriott, and Sheraton CLT Airport Hotel

SOUTH CHARLOTTE

Visiting friends or family south of 485 and want to stay somewhere in between them and the center city? UNIVERSITY CITY (North Charlotte)

If your travels require you to stay north of the city, opt for the UNC Charlotte Marriott University City to be closest to the university.

If arts and history are what you're after, there will be plenty to explore.

LEVINE CENTER FOR THE ARTS Uptown

The Center encompasses three different museums (or you could visit them separately) allowing you to experience a diverse range of art and culture. Included in the two day pass is the *Bechtler Museum of Modern Art, Harvey B. Gantt Center for African-American Arts + Culture* and the *Mint Museum* (both locations).

With the majority of the locations being all in the one central hub Uptown, you can explore the vibrant plazas, public art, stunning architecture, contemporary sculptures, societal themes, pop-up events, shopping, dining and more. At the *Bechtler Museum of Modern Art* you can expect to find an exhibition of mid-20th-century modern art and until recently, only a handful of the artworks in the Bechtler collection have been on public view in the United States, as they were mostly kept as a private collection by the Bechtler family of Switzerland. Named after Harvey Gantt, the first African-American mayor and first African-American student at Clemson, a South Carolina University, the *Gantt Center* focuses on celebrating the contributions that African-Americans have made to American culture. The *Mint Museum* has two locations, both displaying permanent collections and special exhibits throughout the year. Its Uptown location houses American and international collections and contemporary art. Also the original branch of the United States Mint, the Randolph location was the first art museum in North Carolina and includes a reference library of more than 18,000 volumes.

MUSEUM OF ILLUSIONS

Uptown

Fun for all ages, this interactive museum features immersive installations that are a mind-bending reminder that nothing is really quite as it seems. Bring your camera and look for the photo op locations throughout the venue.

CHARLOTTE MUSEUM OF HISTORY

East Charlotte

On this eight acre campus you'll find the oldest surviving house in Mecklenburg county. Their collection focuses on the Revolutionary period in American history and those that helped shape the Charlotte region.

WINERIES

While Charlotte itself has several great spots to have a nice glass of wine, we are thin on actual vineyards. There are a few within an hour or two away. **Treehouse**, **Veronet**, **Rocky River**, and **Divine Llama** to name a few. My favorite though is **Raffaldini Vineyards** for its beautiful landscape and views. Tip: go on the hike if possible.

NEIGHBORHOODS AROUND CHARLOTTE

It's no surprise that lifestyle tends to drive the decision for where in a city you choose to live. Charlotte is full of diversity and lends itself to eclectic and traditional neighborhoods both. Whether you're looking for a vibrant, walkable areas or quiet, suburban communities, you'll find it in Charlotte

With dining, shopping, parks, sports, music and more, there is something for everyone here in the Queen City.

If sociable, sporty and energetic is your vibe, **UPTOWN** is for you.

Choose from cheese boards to craft pizza at The Market at 7th Street, global cuisine with a Southern twist at Mimosa Grill or the daily prix fixe menus at McNinch House Restaurant for fine dining in the circa-1892 Victorian-era home of a historic Charlotte mayor.




Enjoy drinks with a view at Merchant & Trade, an impressive wine list and classic cocktails at La Belle Helene or food and drinks at one of the many options in historic Latta Arcade and Brevard Court. Experience the late night lounge vibe at Crave with decadent desserts. Stay at the Grand Bohemian and book dinner reservations for an elegant experience at Mico.

Stroll around Uptown through Romare Bearden Park, get to know Charlotte's history with the KNOW CLT app or catch a show at one of the Blumenthal Performing Arts venues, like the Knight Theater (adjacent to the Bechtler Museum of Modern Art in the Levine Center for the Arts) or Belk Theater. Catch a concert at the Spectrum Center or the BOA Stadium.

Bask in the walkability of the **Fourth Ward** historic district and peep the **history map** on the corner of W Sixth St and N Poplar St.





Thinking of a modern, sophisticated, urban space? **MIDTOWN** may be it.

With a skyline view and amenities walkable via the Little Sugar Creek Greenway, which runs from Center City through the neighborhood, Midtown offers a wide variety of dining from Mama Ricotta's – a traditional Italian restaurant serving the city for over three decades – to Pisces Sushi whose menu features rolls, entrees, hibachi and an

enticing wagyu burger. Enjoy the warm and welcoming environment of **Dressler's** for high-end plates featuring sustainably farmed ingredients that create delectable Southern dishes.


Drink award-winning craft beer from the rooftop terrace of **Devil's Logic Brewing**, tucked away in the center of this just-outside-of-Uptown neighborhood, or enjoy casual cocktails at **Midtown Tavern**.

Grab a latte at Waterbean Coffee before grabbing breakfast at the Original Pancake House, followed by strolling the greenway or Midtown Park, complete with open green space and Living Lenses, a Braille music box translating Braille letters into musical notes. Stroll the shops of the Metropolitan for home goods or dance the night away with a class at Midtown Ballroom.

Blocks from Uptown, you can take home fresh delicacies from the **Kings Drive Farmers Market** where you can find it all, from fruits and vegetables, fresh herbs, baked goods, beautiful bouquets of cut flowers, fresh meats from nearby farms, and even your holiday Christmas tree.

If you want established, cozy and historic, DILWORTH is for you.

Taste Indian flavors in a turn-of-thecentury bungalow that has housed **Copper Modern Indian Cuisine** since its opening in 2005. **300 East** has served the city since 1986 and remains a favorite from weekend



brunch to dinner. Sit beside the koi pond of **Dilworth Tasting Room** for wine and cocktails, enjoy a night out at The **Bar at 316**, complete with drag shows and karaoke, and sip fine wine at **Mere's** or grab it to go.

Step in **Paper Skyscraper** for stationery, books and Charlotte-centric gifts or **PlantHouse** for a drink at the bar and a terrarium workshop.

If you want friendly, picturesque and mature, MYERS PARK is it.

Dine on upscale California-inspired cuisine at Napa on Providence or Italian fare at Stagioni in a 1926 Tuscan-style villa then take a drive down the gorgeous Queens Rd West. For Southern staples, stop in Reid's Fine Foods, a butcher shop and specialty foods store founded in 1928.

Sip on upscale cocktails at **Dot Dot Dot**, a members-only cocktail lounge, peruse the casual nightlife of Montford Avenue and visit **Good Food on Montford** for wine and cocktails or stop in **Selwyn Avenue Pub**,



a neighborhood gathering spot serving Myers Park for over 30 years.

Shop and dine at Park Road Shopping Center, a destination since its 1956 opening. Stroll around the fountains and greenway at Freedom Park or marvel at the grounds and art exhibits of Mint Museum. Feeling a youthful, vibrant, trendy scene and absolutely love dogs? SOUTH END is for you.

Take the Light Rail from Uptown and find yourself in this playful, old mill district. Grab breakfast to start your day at Ruby Sunshine's or Snooze AM Eatery.



Be amazed by the world's largest beer selection on tap at Charlotte Beer Garden. Step into The Salted Melon Market & Eatery for counter service, brunch and easy-going nightlife. Start your dance party at The Music Yard at SouthBound and finish the night at Broken Promises. For rooftop eats, try The Waterman Fish Bar for delicacies like lobster rolls and daily oyster specials.

Sip cider at **Red Clay Ciderworks**, coffee and natural wine from **Stable Hand** and locally crafted brews at **Sycamore Brewing's** new multilevel location, a newly imagined South End staple. Hop over across the street to **Puttery** for a cool ambiance, tasty cocktails and indoor putt putt. Get your pets in with dogs galore in the streets.

Play a round of pinball and pingpong at **Pins Mechanical Co**. Bike the rail trail after making your own candles at **Paddywax Candle Bar** and then head to **Atherton Mill** for shopping and dining. Art lovers go gallery hopping and explore dozens of brightly colored murals painted throughout the neighborhood by local artists.

Walk past the **Confetti Hearts Wall** heading to **Barcelona Wine Bar** for Spanish tapas and wine for date night. Don't skip a Charlotte staple, **Hawker's Asian Street Food**, then take in the dreamy aroma of **Jenni's Splendid Ice Cream** and grab yourself a waffle cone.

If the eclectic, artsy and playful vibe is more you, then NODA is your spot!

Named for its main street, North Davidson, this walkable hipster haven is full of craft beers, local artists and easy-going energy. 




Love all things outdoors and want to be out of the main city? LAKE NORMAN is a spot to consider.


